Eligibility

- A citizen of Ethiopia

- The student must be in her/his final year of studies or must have graduated in the 2020/2021 academic year
- A cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher

Note: Other criteria may be added

Application

- Students are expected to submit an application for the mentorship program

- 10 students will be selected (the number may change)
- Results will be communicated by email (only those accepted will be informed)
